Can you hear that? It's the blowing of the trumpets announcing the visitation of Lord! **It's HARVEST TIME** in the Body of Christ!

The alarm has sounded as the season of the "IN Gathering," the Feast of Tabernacles has come. The Feast of Tabernacles, also known as the Feast of Booths, is the seventh and last feast that the Lord commanded Israel to observe. For seven days, we are to joyfully celebrate and "appear before the Lord your God in the place which He shall choose. For the LORD your God will bless you in all your harvest and in all the work of your hands, and your joy will be complete" (Deuteronomy 16:13-16).

According to the Hebrew calendar, the Feast of Tabernacles takes place on the 15th of the Hebrew month Tishri. This was the seventh month and usually occurs in late September to mid-October. The feast begins five days after the Day of Atonement and at the time the fall harvest is completed. It was, and continues to be, a time of jubilant celebration and great expectation. The Israelites remember God's faithful provision and protection during the forty years in the wilderness. And the body of Christ, today, joins in that celebration continually thanking God for all he has done.

During this season, allow your expectations to rise and be mixed with faith. It was during the Feast of Tabernacles that Solomon's Temple was dedicated to the Lord and the promise was fulfilled (1 Kings 8:2). It was during the Feast of Tabernacles that the people who returned to rebuild the temple gathered together to hear Ezra proclaim the word of God, causing a great revival to sweep the city (Nehemiah 8). It was during this feast that Jesus said, "if any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink. He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water (John 7:37-38)."

Masterfully positioned in the season of the Feast of Tabernacles is Holy Convocation 2018! We expect signs! We expect miracles! We expect a deluge and outpouring of the Holy Spirit!

We expect nothing less than the power of God flowing in our midst! We expect a holy visitation!

The Feast of Tabernacles was instituted by God as a way to constantly remind every generation of Israel's deliverance from Egypt. This feast is unique in that the Gentile nations were invited to come up to Jerusalem along with the Israelites to worship the Lord at this appointed time so they could also learn to fear the Lord (Deuteronomy 31:12). Today, the body of Christ celebrates knowing that the Feast was a foreshadowing of the ultimate deliverance and salvation through the coming Messiah!

Incense Ministries was founded by the visionary, Apostle Steve Green, to release the sweet savor of worship as incense unto the Lord. As Apostle Green cast vision for this year's Holy Convocation, he exhorted us from 2 Corinthians 2:15 (AMP), reminding us to be "the sweet fragrance of Christ which exhales unto God." Apostle Green declared that "the odor of your worship is the odor of your life." As a general in the body of Christ, times arise that cause the fragrance of worship to turn from a sweet odor to the stench of death. The Holy Convocation of Incense Ministries is designed to be the answer and the adjustment in our worship.

Having released nearly 400 ministers by license and/or ordination, Incense Ministries annually summons over 30 churches, ministers, and other leaders together during Holy Convocation: The Ingathering. Once again, the Incense Ministerial Alliance has come together to deal with end time issues and to minister to those generals of the body of Christ who are called to the front line.

The Incense Ministerial Alliance 8th Annual Holy Convocation takes place Oct. 10-14. This is your time to appear before the Lord. For he shall bless you in all of your harvest, in all of your work, and your joy shall be made complete!
